Greetings Friends,

Now that you're reading this, we have made it to February, or at least a day or two away from it. We have had snow, ice, and even bitter cold but we have lots of winter left. But as of February 1^{st,} we are 50 days from spring. Even closer is Ash Wednesday that is on February 14th this year. I find it ironic that Ash Wednesday shares Valentine's Day this year. But it does make sense I guess as Valentine's Day is the day, we are to show those we love how special they are to us, Ash Wednesday helps us to remember the absolute love that Christ showed us as we prepare for His death and resurrection. So, I guess February 14th has a double meaning for us, we are doubly blessed.

The season of Lent is a time for us to assess ourselves and make adjustments. It's a time for us to recalibrate to God's way of living and loving. The purpose of repentance and reflection is not to lay ourselves under condemnation, but to offer ourselves up for salvation. In Christ, we can let go of the sin and shame that seek to enslave us.

This series will take us through to Easter morning and will teach us that Jesus did not merely come to set us free from the consequences of our sins. But that He also came to set us free from the power of sin. It is my hope that we, as a community of believers, will have a more healthy, sustainable, and enjoyable experience of faith as a result of the words and Scripture shared. Let's come together during this time as we anticipate what the Lord has for us.

Ash wednesday marks the beginning of the Christian season known as Lent. Historically, Lent was a time when new Christians prepared themselves for baptism on Easter Sunday. Today, Lent more often is a time when Christians prepare themselves for Easter and are invited to deeper faith, stronger community, and a closer connection to God.

Lent is a season for changing your life, for turning things around, for getting back on the right path, repentance. It last for 40 days (not counting Sundays); reminding us of the flooding rains of Noah's time (Genesis 7:17-19), Israel wandering in the wilderness (Numbers 23:13), and of Jesus' temptation in the desert (Mark 1:12-13).

The ashes of Ash Wednesday remind us of our mortality. God created humankind from the dust of the earth, and it is to dust that we shall all return. Our time on this earth is short – are we living the life to which God has called us? Are we prepared to give an account for how we have spent our days?

Ash Wednesday isn't a cheerful celebration. But if we take it seriously, Ash Wednesday can be the beginning of a changed life. Are you ready for more? Deeper faith, stronger community, and a closer relationship with God?




The Lord bless you

Dealing with Heartbreak

Whether it's a friend, a family member, or a loved one we all have felt the pain of losing someone that was special to us. When this happens it is important that we remember that God knows what is best for us. I saw this post on Facebook that said Bison are the only animals that turn and move right into a snowstorm. Bison know that walking into the storm will get them through the bad weather quicker. Walking to God instead of away from him is the only REAL way through that pain you feel. I know how painful, and traumatic it can be sometimes. Those wounds on the inside are so much harder to heal because we can relive them in our minds again, and again. But friends only Jesus can give you the REAL healing that you need.

The devil tries to mimic everything that God does. Rest assured that he will try and offer you fake comfort. He will say things like aren't you so lonely you need addiction to numb the pain because you can't handle your feelings. You need that bad relationship because you're lonely and no one else will ever love you. Don't you want to feel loved? Go look for the wrong type of love, go back to those people that keep hurting you, numb your pain. You are not enough, and this is the best that you will ever get. Oh no don't you feel rejected, you're hurt, hurt them back! Look over there at what that person has. They have so many friends that love them, they have a mom and a dad, they have brothers and sisters. Maybe you feel sad when you see all that they have that you don't have. Maybe you even get envious. God why isn't that in my life plan? But that is not from God. And that Jealousy will lead to hate in your heart and bitterness. God created us to feel, the problem is when we let our emotions lead us and not God. We should give our bad feelings to God.

Maybe God has a purpose for all that pain in your life. Maybe you need to practice self-control so that you can handle the right relationship. Maybe God needs you to work on your Christ like attributes so that he can bless you. Maybe God is waiting for exactly the right moment to pour out his blessing to you. God's timing is perfect. Maybe God gave us that pain so that we would help other people. We must trust that God has a purpose for our pain. And that he is working on all things for our good. There is no such thing as a painless lesson. We can't gain things without losing things first. Sacrifice the fake, the fake love, the fake comfort, the fake miracles, so that Jesus can give you the REAL healing that you need. I know that it is so much easier to run away from the storms in life. But the only REAL way out of the storm is to run right into it, straight to our father in heaven. Step into the light so that God can heal you.


