












Do you want to help with the Youth?

Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. ³⁸ Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Matthew 9:37-38

There are so many people in need, both physically and spiritually. Are we laboring to meet those needs? Or are we distracted by unimportant things? Do you have a fundraising idea to help support our Missions outreach? What else can we do to get more people involved and excited to help spread the Word of God?

What has the FCCW Missions Committee been up to? That's a great question!!!!

They have been doing some fundraising recently. We are doing our 2nd 40 Days Challenge in the book of Matthew. This fundraiser has raised \$640 for our Missions. (The first raised \$800) Keep on the lookout for more in the future!

They have been selling the "Love Like Jesus" boxes and the profit from those goes to the By the Book program in Huntington. We have sold 15 boxes which means 15 bibles will be purchased for Huntington County youth. The Mission's committee is passionate about this program and has matched that number giving money to purchase another 15 bibles. Thank you everyone! Check Box #2 available now!

The Mission's committee has been in touch with the inmate advocate at the Huntington county jail. They asked if our church could help with purchasing bibles and Spanish reading materials to be used in the class at the jail. 25 bibles were purchased along with other Spanish reading materials.

A purchase was made of 100 "Armor of God" pins for part of our outreach program. The Mission's committee is always looking for new ways to reach out into the community and plant the seeds of God.

Along with all these great things they have also continued with their monthly donations of \$100 to the Huntington Remnant House, \$100 to the New Life Meal Ministry, and \$50 to the Bread of Life Food Pantry here in Warren.

One of our largest missions here at FCCW has been the food collection for our local food pantry. Rose lets us know each month what is needed, and our church goes above and beyond to provide the item in need. This month she asked for mushroom soup to add to the Thanksgiving boxes she gives out. You make this project a success! Thank you.





Our Jesus Box" contains thoughtfully handpicked items to enhance your daily walk with Jesus. Each box contains a book or devotional and 3-4 other items for you to enjoy. 
November 17th, following service. Join us for a
